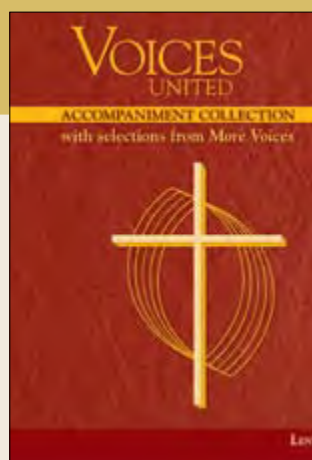
Gathering Lent/Easter/ Pentecost 2012

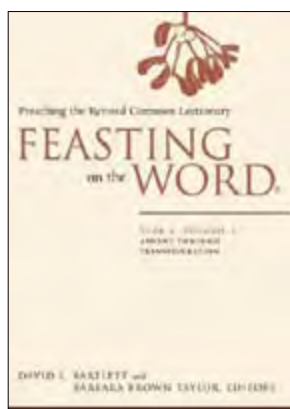


Voices United Accompaniment Collection with Selections from *More Voices* Lent and Easter/Pentecost

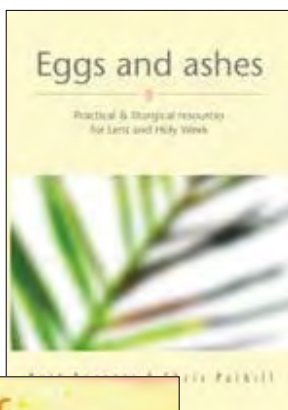
Feasting on the Word: Preaching the Revised Common Lectionary

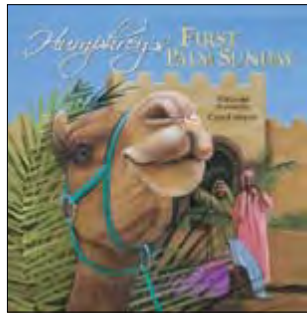


The Easter Story

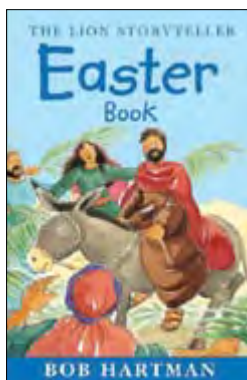


Humphrey's First Palm Sunday

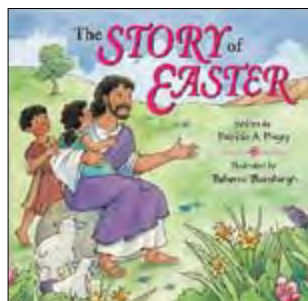


The Story of Easter

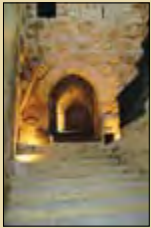

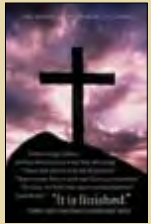
